Following corrections are required in UET2020 and PET2020 Information Bulletins, to be issued as *Corrigendum* by the Office of the Controller of Examinations:

## **UET Bulletin**

1 Page No. 14 MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS for B.Sc.(Hons)Ag./B.Sc.(Hons)Ag.-RGSC may now be read as follows:

"A candidate shall be eligible for admission to B.Sc.(Hons)Ag., if he/she has passed 10+2 OR equivalent examination securing a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate."

2. Page No.39: Point (a) of INTER-SE RANKING may now be read as follows:

"In case of However for admission to BSc the aggregate marks in Science subjects shall only be considered for this purpose."

## PET Bulleting

Page No. 47: Point (xxviii): M.Sc.(Ag.) in Soil Science — Soil and Water Conservation (Under Special Courses of Study) may now be read as:

"There shall be one paper of 120 minutes duration carrying 360 marks containing 120 multiple-choice questions based on B.Sc.(Hons)Ag./B.Sc.(Ag.) courses related to Soil Science including Soil and Water Conservation."

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
